Visa & Registration: If you plan to travel outside Moscow, you should inform the International Office before your departure. After your return to Moscow, you must go to the International Office to register again within three days of your arrival.

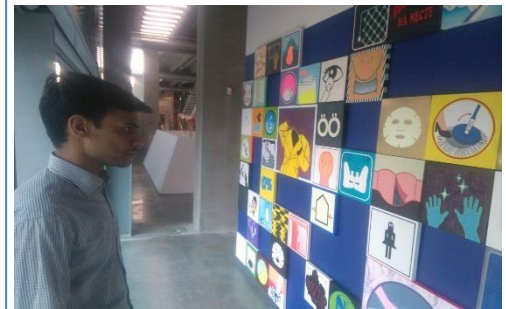
