1. GORKY CENTRAL PARK OF CULTURE AND LEISURE



Gorky Park is the capital's central park, with more than 40,000 visitors on weekdays and 250,000 on weekends and public holidays. Since 2011, the park has been setting new standards, becoming Russian's first world-class park and a space for recreation, sport, dance and outdoor games.
