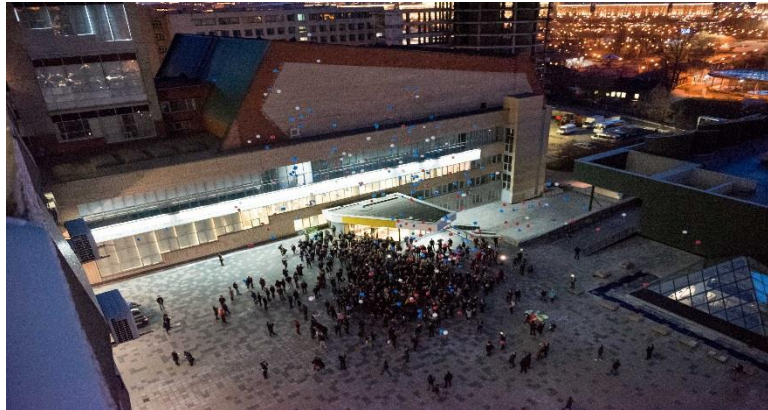


International Horizon

On this day in 1990, the Russian parliament declared Russian sovereignty from the USSR. Concerts and fireworks take place in many cities throughout the country.
