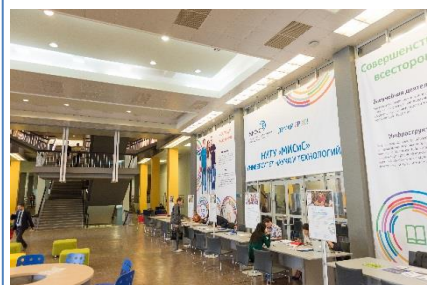

The “**Moscow International Film Festival**” is among the oldest in the world. It was held for the first time in 1935. The MIFF paved the way for filmmakers who later became known throughout the world like Istvan Szabo, Kaneto Shindo, Krzysztof Kieslowski, and Aki Kaurismaki. In mid-July 2017, **Moscow City Racing** will take place. Formula One teams will race around the Kremlin with top drivers taking to the streets. The event starts at Bolotnaya Ploshchad and follows the southern wall of the Kremlin along Kremlyovskaya Naberezhnaya to Bolshoi Kamenny Bridge. The track is about 4500m long. Spectators traditionally see nearly a hundred of cars.
