

Introduction of 2024 Harbin University of Science and Technology Chinese Government Scholarship (Silk Road Scholarship)

By the authorization of Chinese Ministry of Education, Harbin University of Science and Technology (HUST) is the institution admitting international students under Chinese government scholarship program. The Silk Road Scholarship is a full scholarship of CSC to support Harbin University of Science and Technology to select and recruit outstanding international students for graduate studies in program of Electrical Engineering. It only supports master's programs and doctoral programs.

The School of Electrical and Electronic Engineering of Harbin University of Science and Technology, which was established in 1950, is a discipline with national characteristics to meet the needs of high-end talent training and technical services in Northeast China and even the national electrical equipment manufacturing industry. The School has a high-level faculty led by academicians and national talents, and five key laboratories and engineering centers of national key disciplines and national ministries and commissions such as the Ministry of science and technology, the Ministry of education and the national development and Reform Commission. The School continues to focus on the international academic frontier and major national needs of the discipline, give full play to the advantages of the discipline in basic research, technology integration and the combination of industry, University and research in the field of modern electrical equipment manufacturing and intelligent operation, and become a first-class teaching and scientific research base integrating scientific research, talent training, achievement transformation and serving the society. The discipline recruited master's

students in 1978, obtained the first batch of master's degree authorization points in 1981, obtained the doctor's degree authorization points in 1998, owned the post doctoral mobile station in 2000, obtained the first-class doctor's degree authorization point in 2003, and was owned the national key discipline in 2007. In 2017, the electrical engineering department was selected as the advantageous and characteristic discipline in Heilongjiang Province, and was approved to build a domestic first-class discipline. In 2018, "Engineering" entered the top 1% discipline of ESI in the world.

The Master/Ph.D. program of Electrical Engineering covers five secondary level disciplines (research fields), including Motors and Electrical Appliances, Power System and its Automation, High Voltage and Insulation Technology, Power Electronics and Power Transmission, Electrical Theory and New Technology, among which the discipline of High Voltage and Insulation Technology is a national key discipline

1. Project Name

The applicant submits a study application directly to our school.

2. Apply for a major

4. Language of Instruction and Requirement

1. Apply for Master's and doctoral degrees:

● Applicants who choose English as the medium language, should have adequate English language proficiency (holding TOFEL, IELTS or other English certificates will be given priority) , If a standardized English test certificate cannot be provided, applicants who have used English teaching in the previous stage of degree learning must provide relevant certificates. Applicants whose native language is English are exempt from providing proof of their English proficiency as mentioned above.

● Applicants who choose Chinese as the medium language, should have adequate Chinese language proficiency (holding valid HSK4 and above certificate) ;

5. Coverage of Chinese Government

Scholarship

Full Scholarship

- A waiver fee of registration, tuition.
- Free on-campus dormitory accommodation.
- A living allowance at the following rates(per month),

Doctoral program student: CNY3500. Master program student: CNY3000.

Scholarship recipients registering before the 15th of the registration month (the 15th included) will be granted the full living allowance of that

month. Recipients registering after the 15th of the registration month will be granted half of the living allowance of that month.

● Free Comprehensive Medical Insurance for International Students in China.

6.Application Requirement

● Be a citizen of a country other than the People's Republic of China, and be in good health;

● Applying for Electrical Engineering

● Master's students must hold a bachelor's degree and be under the age of 35; Doctoral students must hold a master's degree and be under the age of 40;

● The applicant should meet the admission requirements for academic ability, language proficiency, and other related aspects of the applied major.

Attention:

Chinese government scholarship students are not allowed to enjoy the support of other scholarships (excluding various one-time rewards) established by Chinese governments at all levels and admission institutions at the same time. Once discovered, their eligibility for Chinese government scholarships will be cancelled and they must return the Chinese government scholarships they have received. Those who deliberately conceal their funding situation are not allowed to apply for Chinese government scholarships for three years, except for disqualification.

7.Application Documents

The applicant must fill in and provide the following materials truly and correctly:

1. Application Form for Chinese Government Scholarship (to be filled out in Chinese or English)

2.Scanned copy of passport front page. The applicant must submit a clear scanned copy of the front page of their ordinary passport, which is valid after September 2024;

3.The highest educational certificate notarized. If the applicant is a current student, they must provide an expected graduation certificate or proof of enrollment issued by their school of study.

4.Academic transcripts (from undergraduate level). Scanned copies of transcripts should include the results of the undergraduate, master's (if any), doctoral (if any) study stage up to the most recent semester. Transcripts should be issued and stamped by the Academic Affairs Office, Graduate School, or relevant student administration department of the school where they are attending. Transcripts in Chinese/English can be

provided, and if they are in English or foreign languages, English translations and notarization are required.

5. Valid English Certificate. Applicant who applies for Chinese language teaching should provide valid HSK4 and above certificate. Applicant who applies for English language teaching should provide IELTS or TOEFL score or other proof that support the applicant's capability of English.

6. A study or research plan in Chinese or in English (no less than 1000 words), and applicant for Ph.D. program must have a Chinese tutor's signature on the plan.

7. Two letters of recommendation in Chinese or English by professors or associate professors. The letters should focus on the requirements of the applicant's learning objectives in China, the cooperation or inter school communication between Chinese universities or Chinese tutors and foreign tutors, and the evaluation of the applicant's comprehensive ability and future development, which can only be written in Chinese or English.

8. A photocopy of the Foreigner Physical Examination Form completed in English (The original should be kept by the applicant. Please bring the original with you when coming to China. This form is printed by the Chinese health and quarantine department and must be filled out in English.) The physical examinations must cover all the items listed in the Foreigner Physical Examination Form. Incomplete records or those without the signature of the attending physician, the official stamp of the hospital or a sealed photograph of the applicants are invalid. Please select the appropriate time to take physical examination as the result is valid for only 6 months.

9. Certificate of no criminal record, written in Chinese or English. The applicant must submit a certificate of no criminal record within the valid period issued by the local public security organ, usually within 6 months before the date of submitting the application.

10. Confirmation Form for Harbin Institute of Technology Graduate Supervisor's Intended Acceptance of International Students (Attachment 2), written in Chinese or English. Applicants can search for mentor information on the school's website and obtain contact information: You can search for mentor information on the school website and get in touch: Log in to the school website <http://www.hrbust.edu.cn/> → Enrollment and employment → Graduate enrollment → Mentor team → Mentor information → Select the School of Electrical and Electronic Engineering and search for mentor information.

Note: When applicants first provide application materials, they must prepare 1-9 items, if the applicant can provide the tenth material, it will increase the probability of being admitted.

9.Tips to Apply

(1) Applicants can directly consult the International Cooperation and Exchange Office of Harbin University of Science and Technology.

(2) Visit the website of [http: www.campuschina.org](http://www.campuschina.org) to enter the application system. After successful registration, log on to the system with the registered account.

(3) Complete the applicant's "personal data". The applicant must complete the entry of personal data before filling in the application information.

(4) Select the correct "type of overseas study program". Please select the category of "Type B". And start entering the application information.

(5) The Agency code" of Harbin University of Science and Technology is 10214.

(6) Fill in the "Application Information". Enter "Language Competency and Learning Plan" and upload "Supplementary Materials" until you click [Submit] to complete the application.

Please carefully check the correctness and authenticity of all information and supplementary materials before submitting the application.

(7) Once the application is submitted, the applicant will not be able to modify the "personal data" and "application information". Before the application is accepted, the applicant can withdraw the submitted application and modify it by clicking Cancel. After the application is

withdrawn, the applicant must submit it again after edit, otherwise the application cannot be accepted. After the application is accepted, the applicant will not be able to withdraw the application (before the formal acceptance of the application, it is possible to receive an email from the Department of International Cooperation and Exchange of Harbin University of Science and Technology providing additional "supplementary materials". At that time, please provide additional application materials as required by the email).

(8)Click "Print Application" to download the application form.

(9)Prepare all the application materials as required and send the electronic version to jiyongjin69@163.com.

Note:

(1) Firefox or IE browser is recommended. If you use IE browser, please remove the "Compatibility View Mode" of the browser and use it.

(2) The applicant must complete all application information in Chinese or English.

Note:

1. The materials uploaded in the system must be clear and complete. Applicants are advised to use professional equipment to scan the relevant documents to be submitted, and the consequences caused by unclear or unrecognizable uploaded materials shall be borne by the applicant. At the same time, please be sure to provide your accurate phone number, email address and mailing address (including zip code and city information) in the application form.

2. In addition to the above materials, Harbin University of Science and Technology has the right to require the applicant to provide other necessary application materials.

3. Applicants should send the electronic version of the application materials to jiyongjin69@163.com, and in mid-May, some applicants will receive an online assessment (written test or interview) notice from Harbin University of Science and Technology.

4. Applicants who do not receive the email notification from our school before early June can be regarded as failing to pass the preliminary examination.

10.Admission Procedures and Notices

- 1.The school is responsible for reviewing the application materials and determining the candidates to be admitted according to the comprehensive assessment results;**
- 2.The proposed candidates,after being reviewed and approved by experts from the China Scholarship Council, will be eligible for the Silk Road Scholarship from the Chinese government to study in China;**
- 3.Each scholarship recipient is eligible for only one Chinese Government scholarship program;**
- 4.Our school will send the electronic version of the admission materials to the designated email address of the admitted students before mid August;**
- 5.Scholarship recipients are not allowed to change their admission institution after coming to China; Not allowed to change the study major and duration;**
- 6.Scholarship eligibility will not be retained for those who fail to study in China within the admission period without valid reasons.**

11.Visa application and registration

- (1)Admitted scholarship students should go to the Chinese embassy (consulate) in the country where the scholarship student is located to apply for a visa (X1 visa) with the original ordinary passport, "Admission Notice" and "Visa Application Form for Foreign Students Studying in China" (JW201) (before applying for a visa, it is recommended to consult the Chinese embassy (consulate) in the country where the scholarship student is located for visa processing matters in advance);**
- (2)Go to the School of Foreign Chinese Language of Harbin University of Science and Technology to go through the registration procedures according to the enrollment registration date specified in the "Admission Notice" (scholarship students can enjoy the free airport pick-up service provided by the school if they register on the date specified by the school);**
- (3)New students must enter the country with a personal ordinary passport and X1 visa, and apply for a residence permit within 30 days after entering the country.**
