As part of its yearly tradition to celebrate Epiphany, Russian Orthodox Christians bathe in icy rivers and ponds to mark the baptism of Jesus Christ. **Epiphany** marks the baptism of Jesus in the River Jordan by Saint John and is traditionally held in Russia, which uses the Julian calendar, on January 19.
