For this, it is necessary to apply to the MISIS Migration Department (Leninsky Prospekt, 6, office 370 (pink building of the Mining Institute)).

We draw your attention that all visas and registrations are issued only if there is a valid insurance policy of voluntary medical insurance.

The cost of the policy: 6,500 rubles for 1 year. The University concluded cooperation agreements with 4 leading insurance companies: Energogrant, VSK, Evroins and YuzhUral Zhaso. You can choose any of them.
