Preparation for the Competition

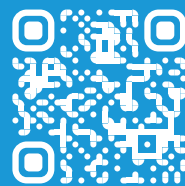
To prepare for Open Doors, participants should

- familiarize themselves with the Open Doors Rules of Participation
- choose the track that corresponds to their age and educational background
- select a subject area and check its program and Stage 2 sample tasks
- review the recommended study materials and online courses
- ensure that their computer equipment meets the Open Doors technical requirements
- if admitted to Stage 2, test their computer equipment before completing the competition tasks

Open Doors Winner Status

Awarded to participants who successfully complete all stages and tasks required for their selected track and subject area

Winners should

- complete the application form for the Education Quota for foreign citizens in the Russian Federation in the Open Doors account
- submit the required documents through the Open Doors account
- monitor the Education Quota status for foreign citizens in the Russian Federation

The winner's application form includes

For the Bachelor's and Master's tracks

- language of instruction
- field of study
- up to six universities in order of preference

For the Doctoral (PhD) track

- language of instruction
- research specialization agreed upon with a prospective research supervisor

Grant Support Includes

- coverage of travel to the place of study and return travel upon completion of studies
- a monthly allowance, subject to maintaining good or excellent academic standing
- coverage of voluntary medical insurance
- reimbursement of accommodation expenses during the period of study

To Qualify for Grant Support

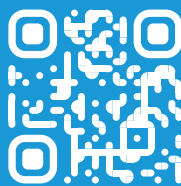
- become a winner in the Bachelor's, Master's or Doctoral (PhD) track
- choose a Russian-taught degree program
- indicate the option of studying at the Preparatory Department for international applicants (in the absence of an education and qualification document issued in Russia)
- provide the full package of documents required for the Education Quota for foreign citizens in the Russian Federation
- obtain verification of the completeness and correctness of the submitted documents for the Education Quota for foreign citizens in the Russian Federation, as well as the official study referral

Russian as the Language of Instruction

Winners who choose Russian as their language of instruction may qualify for grant support

Foreign citizens whose proficiency in Russian is insufficient for their studies may study Russian at the Preparatory Department for foreign citizens of a Russian university:

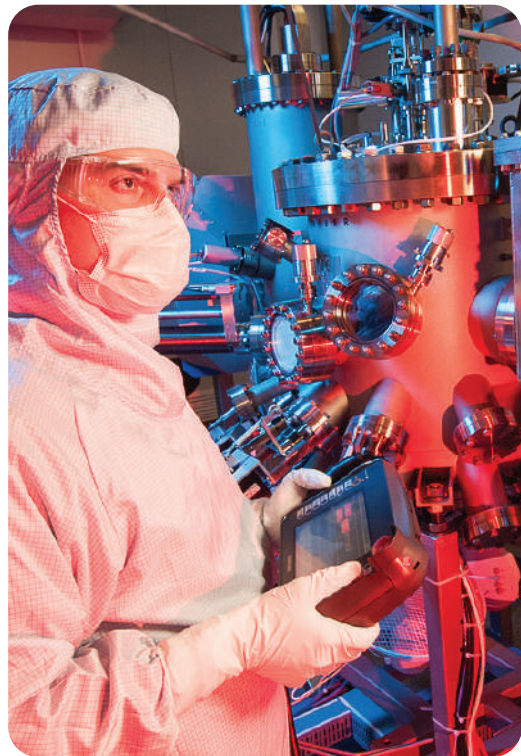
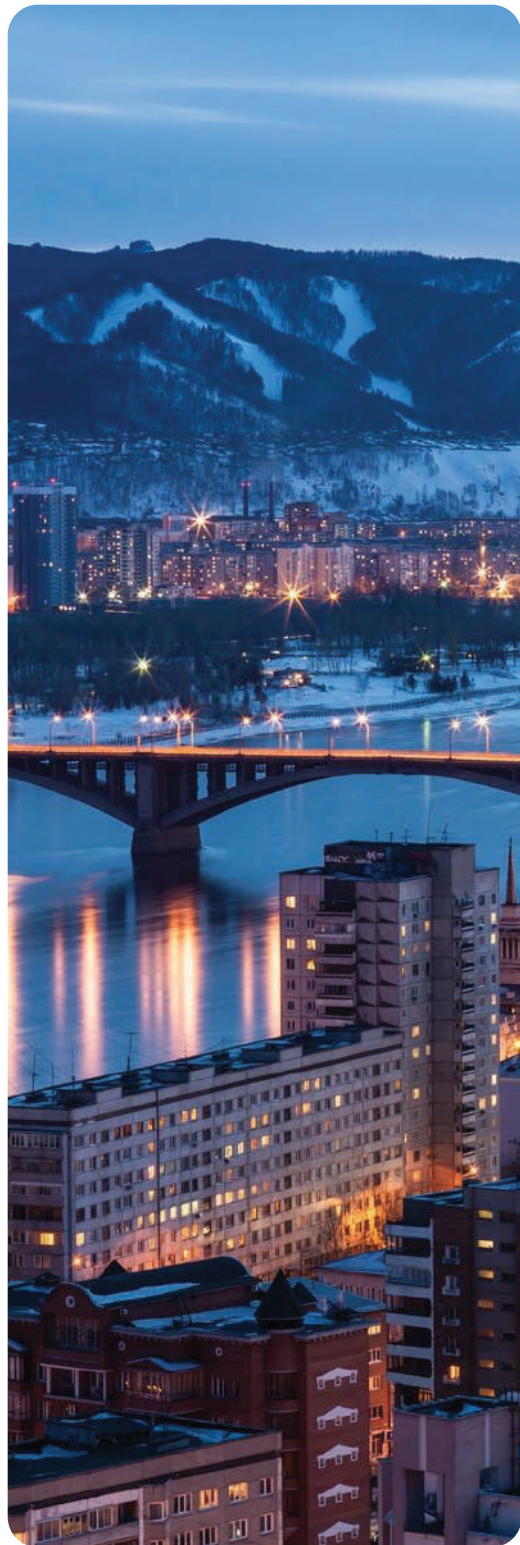
- upon receiving a referral by the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation

- for one academic year

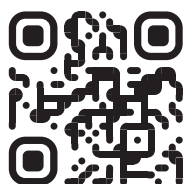
